Script:


Cutout of big fish/whale and Jonah Clothespin Glue or tape Crayons or colored pencils


Instructions:

1. Cut out a large fish and Jonah. You can draw these yourself or print out the PDF.

- 2. Color Jonah and the fish.
- 3. Cut the fish in half horizontally.







4. Glue each half of the fish onto the clothespin (make sure they line up)

5. Glue Jonah onto the reverse side of the clothespin, facing the front of the fish. (He should peek out when you open the clothespin)
